

**Blendon/Georgetown Township
Agreement for Blendon Township's Phase 2
Storm Water management
Program Plan**


Since Blendon Township is required to implement a Phase 2 SWMPP and because Blendon Township relies on Georgetown Township for sanitary sewer services, the following is agreed for Sections 1, 12, and 13:

- As the Permittee with the State, Blendon Township agrees that Blendon Township will manage the Program and file all necessary documents with the State.
- Blendon Township will draft and adopt a Storm Water Ordinance.
- Blendon Township will pass along reports of possible illicit sanitary wastewater connections, infiltration or inflow to Georgetown Township.
- Blendon Township will assist Georgetown Township with the elimination of illicit connections, infiltration or inflow.


Georgetown Township will provide the following:

- Assist Blendon Township to comply with the Phase 2 Storm Water Management Program to the extent that Georgetown Township is responsible as outlined in the following:
 - Sewer Agreement signed November 26, 2001 by the Blendon Township Supervisor, Henry Hofman, and by the Georgetown Township Supervisor, James Holtvluwer, and witnessed by Martha A. LaBarge.
 - Any revisions, amendments or changes made to the Sewer Agreement signed November 26, 2001.
 - Any Sewer Agreement made between Blendon Township and Georgetown Township made subsequently after the date of this agreement.
