To the Utilities Committee,

We are writing to appeal a decision by the Georgetown Township manager denying our request for a refund of a \$500 overpayment we made for our water hook-up fees on December 12, 2019.

In September 2018, we received a letter (attached) from the Township notifying us of the new rate structure for water and connection fees. The letter said that in order to lock in the 2018 rate, “an installment payment must be made by December 28, 2018.”

On December 27, 2018, we made an installment payment of **\$2,102** for our sewer connection fees and a **\$4,514.40** installment payment for our water connection fees. On January 7, 2019, we paid off the balance of our sewer connection fees, **\$18,000**; we paid the entire sewer balance in order to avoid paying interest on that amount.

We hooked up to sewer on December 11, 2019. (Please note that we had made a down payment to the plumbing company in July 2019; this was the soonest they could do the work.) When we attempted to hook up to water we discovered that the lateral had not been installed, so we contacted the township, and on December 12, 2019, we paid **\$3,115** for the water connection fees. When we reviewed our paperwork, we discovered that we were charged the 2019 rate, not the 2018 rate of **\$2,670**, the rate we had locked into on December 27, 2018.

We contacted the township, and after a number of phone calls we were told that because the payment was made online, financing never got set up. We were told that the Township was “not aware of [our] intentions, so the financing piece never kicked in.”—so our payment was not treated as an installment payment.

The letter we received did not say we needed to make our payment in person. The letter did not specify that we needed to set up financing. The letter did not specify that we needed to “make our intentions

known." It simply said to make an installment payment by December 28, 2018, which we, in good faith, did. For this reason we believe the water hook-up fees we paid on December 12 included an overpayment of \$500, the amount for which we are asking for a refund.
