

School Elections

If a school district is holding an election for a new millage or a millage renewal, **only the residents who live on properties in that school district will be allowed to vote.**

For example, if **Grandville Public Schools** is having a millage renewal election, **only** residents of properties in Grandville Public Schools are eligible to vote. **Jenison and Hudsonville Public Schools residents are not eligible to vote.**

It does not matter what school your children attend. Your eligibility to vote in a school election is based entirely on where your parcel of property is located because the school district you pay taxes to is based entirely on where your property is located.

The map below shows Georgetown's school districts: Hudsonville in yellow, Jenison in indigo, and Grandville in green.
