Home Safety Form



SMOKE ALARMS

- Smoke alarms are on every level
- Alarms are inside and outside sleeping areas
- Alarms are tested each month
- Batteries are changed as needed
- Alarms are less than 10 years old

HAVE THE CORRECT SMOKE ALARMS

- **Standard**--photoelectric/or Ionization smoke alarms
- **Bed Shakers**--For hearing impaired and elderly
- **Strobe Lights**--For hearing impaired, and elderly; plugs directly into the wall.
- **Nest**--Smoke/CO combo that alerts your phone when it goes off.



COOKING SAFETY

- Cooking area has no items that can burn
- Cooking area is supervised at all times
- Pot handles always turned toward back of stove



ESCAPE PLAN

- There is a fire escape plan that shows 2 ways out of every room.
- Everyone knows where the safe meeting place is outside the home.
- Everyone living in the house practices the escape plan 2 times a year.



CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS

- Alarms are located on each level of the home
- Alarms are less than 7 years old



ELECTRICAL & APPLIANCE SAFETY

- Dryer lint is cleaned out after each use
- All electrical cords are in good condition and not broken or cut
- All plug outlets are safe and do not feel warm when you touch them.



CANDLE SAFETY

- Candles are in sturdy fire-proof containers that won't be tipped over
- Adults blow out all candles when leaving the room or going to bed.
- Candles are kept out of the reach of children and pets

KNOW THE SYMPTOMS OF CO POISONING

- Headache
- Dizziness
- Weakness
- Upset Stomach
- Vomiting
- Chest Pain
- Confusion
